Northwoods Gearhead Winter Itinerary

Your first stop in Langlade County should be the Antigo/Langlade County Chamber of Commerce to pick up maps, community information and useful advice on family-friendly activities, attractions and trails. We can give you some great suggestions on everything from places to go fishing to the best place to get the perfect souvenir.

Day 1

Morning

For a comfortable, affordable place to stay, consider any of the <u>lodging</u> options throughout the county. With an indoor pool and hot tub, clean rooms, and plenty of parking there's something perfect for you! Continental breakfast may also be included with your stay, or stop at a <u>local restaurant</u>.

Mid-Day

Jump on your sled or ATV and take a ride. You can stop for an early lunch at one of the great <u>restaurants</u> along the route. Langlade County provides an abundance of opportunities for everyone to enjoy <u>snowmobiling</u> and <u>ATVing</u>. Langlade County snowmobile trails are maintained for you by 11 different local clubs and Langlade County. The trails are scenic and traverse glacial terrain, upland hardwood, cedar swamps, and fields. Note: ATVs are allowed on all snowmobile trails 10 days after they open and only if the temperature is below 28 degrees F.

Evening

Finish your day on the trails by grabbing a burger at a <u>local tavern</u>. They have full menus, and full service bars available. Spend some time enjoying the themed interior as you get to know some of the other snowmobilers in the area.

Day 2 Morning

A great way to start today is to take advantage of the hospitality at your **hotel**. Enjoy a delicious continental breakfast.

Mid-Day

After spending all day yesterday on the trails, today is great for spending some time indoors. Perhaps you would like to try **bowling** with friends for a while. **North Star Lanes** features 16 bowling lanes, with bumper bowling available. The **Bar-N-Grill** offers many delicious choices for lunch. They are open from 11 am to close Tuesday through Saturday, 12 pm to 10 pm on Sunday, and 3 pm to close on Monday. If you want to head south, you can also visit **Chet & Emil's** in Birnamwood, open daily at 11 am. They have a four lane bowling alley, with full bar service and a full menu available all the time.

Evening

On your way back to the **hotel**, stop at one of the **grocery stores** and pick up a yummy meal from their deli. The deli's offer several dining choices depending on what you like to eat.

Day 3

Morning

You really want to get back out on the trails today, so a good breakfast is in order. Hop in the car and stop at an area <u>diner</u> for a hearty meal. Remember to ask about specials when you're there.

Mid-Day

You can't wait to get back out on the trails, after all that's why you're here. You can spend all day <u>ATVing</u> or <u>Snowmobiling</u> through the county. Head out to the Pickerel-Pearson area for a different view of the county. ATV's are welcome to use the 500 plus miles of Langlade County Snowmobile Trails as long as the trails have been open for at least 10 days, and if the weather is below 28 degrees. If you don't have an <u>ATV</u> or <u>snowmobile</u>, consider renting one from a local merchant. Remember to travel safely on the busy trails.

Evening

Several <u>dining options</u> are located right on the trail. Find a comfortable place to stop for a cold drink and a hot meal. Visit them for something to tempt your taste buds. While you enjoy your food and drinks, you can get to know some of the locals, check out trail conditions throughout the county, and make some new friends.
